About the size of a deck of cards, the CHAT 50 can also connect to certain cell phones and business or home phones.

A little larger than the CHAT 50, the CHAT 150 contains 3 microphones and a larger speaker and is designed for use in an executive office or small conference room. Like the CHAT 50, the CHAT 150 also connects via USB to the PC or laptop for Skype or VoIP calls. However, the CHAT 150 can also connect directly to certain models of Avaya and Cisco enterprise handsets to provide a vastly improved audio experience for hands-free calls. Both the CHAT 50 and 150 have become extremely popular as the audio component for many video conferencing applications.
